TURREFF HALL VACCINATION CENTRE

Since its opening on 2nd March 2021, Turreff Hall Vaccination Centre has administered approaching 20,000 vaccines as part of the vaccine programme, to patients not only in our local community, but from all over the country.

Clinics have been arranged at times that are suitable for shift workers and those that work away from home as well as the local population. Turreff Hall is perfectly suited to the delivery of the vaccine programme as everything is on one level with no steps and parking outside the entrance. The operation is designed to minimise any queuing and to keep patients safe and comfortable whilst wating for their vaccine.

Patients have expressed appreciation and thanks for their positive experience at receiving their vaccine at Turreff Hall.

The Pharmacy staff and volunteers have received many compliments as well as cards, chocolates and cakes. Needless to say the summer diets have vanished for the majority!

The coming autumn will mean booster jabs along with the usual flu jabs just as the last of the second dose Covid jabs are completed; so the vaccine programme could be continuing at Turreff Hall until the end of the year.



The Parish Council would like to thank Donnington Pharmacy, their staff, and all the nurses and volunteers who are giving their time and energy for such a worthwhile cause. It is a privilege to have such an incredible activity at the centre of the community.

DEFIBRILLATORS

An Automated External Defibrillator (AED) is a portable life saving device that can give a casualty's heart an electric shock, when it has stopped beating normally in a sudden cardiac arrest.

A defibrillator works by checking the casualty's heart rhythm once the defibrillator pads are placed on their chest and giving them a shock if needed.

Defibrillators can be used on adults or children over one year old.

By using a defibrillator before an ambulance arrives, you can significantly increase someones chance of survival.

The Parish Council is looking to organise a Free Community Defibrillator Course, designed to promote the use of these life saving AEDs, educate on how to use them and increase the confidence of those using them in an emergency.

GRANVILLE WASTE SITE

The Environment Agency (EA) have been contacted by the Parish Council regarding complaints received about noxious smells emanating from Granville Waste Site.

The Environment Agency stated that the license is the same as it was for the previous license and that there is to be no tipping of hazardous landfill.

Asbestos is allowed as there is a special area and controls in place at the site.

There is also an odour management system in place at the site and during the times the EA had arrived unannounced, no noxious smells had been detected.

The EA is aware of complaints being made to the Parish and Borough Councils but requested that complaints be made directly to the EA on its 24hr hotline.

B E M FOR COUNCILLOR NIGEL DUGMORE

The Parish Council would like to congratulate Councillor Nigel Dugmore for receiving the British Empire Medal (BEM) in the Queen's Honours list for services provided during the Covid pandemic.

"British Empire Medal (BEM) Is awarded for a 'hands-on' service to the local community. This could be a long-term charitable or voluntary activity, or innovative work of a relatively short duration (3 to 4 years) that has made a significant difference"

"I was surprised and delighted to be recognised in the Queens Birthday Honours for services to pharmacy and the local community. During lockdown the pharmacy continued to trade normal extended hours 7 days a week and around 3,000 patients a week had prescriptions delivered. I was concerned for the health of the staff, yet we were fortunate that no staff contracted Covid and that is still the case today.

It is such an honour to receive this award, but I also accept it on behalf of the fantastic team of people that I work with. Community Pharmacy is the 'Cinderella' of the NHS, we are often the public face of the NHS and have to deal with patients who are frustrated and wound up by the 'system' so I am particularly pleased that Community Pharmacy is being acknowledged and rewarded in such a public manner."

Details will be provided in due time and will


