PROSTATE CANCER AWARENESS EVENT



Donnington and Muxton Parish Council contributed £2,000 to the recent P.S.A testing evening, held at A.F.C Telford United Football Club on 6th September 2021.

It was a huge success.

Overall 701 men of different age groups were tested. Of the 701, 2 gentlemen had P.S.A reading over 200 PSI and were advised to see a doctor asap. 43 tested red, 35 tested amber and the remainder tested green

The total cost to put this test evening on with paper work, nurses and blood tests was £14,850.00.

"We could not have done it without your help and kind donations; we hope to carry these tests out on a yearly basis" - Dennis Briggs

The Clerk passed on the thanks to the Council from the organisers for help in sponsoring the event.
