News in Brief

This Parish Council's Annual Return for the year ended 31st March 2013 has been signed off by the Auditors, Mazars LLP.

Community Engagement Meetings, Donnington

At a meeting held in December a decision was taken to review the format of the community engagement meetings due to frequent low attendance by members of the public.

It was agreed by the Donnington Partnership Trustees and the Community Steering Group that the Community Engagement PACT session will be combined with the regular meetings of the Donnington Partnership Community Safety, Housing and Environment working group. The community engagement (PACT) session will be held at the start of these working group meetings. This prevents time being wasted if members of the public do not attend but still allows officers and representatives to carry out a business meeting.

Street Lighting

This Parish Council currently owns 528 lights situated throughout the parish. Due to lanterns becoming obsolete next year it is having to undergo a renewal programme at a cost of £158,400. The programme will be spread over 5 years to ensure that there will be no increase to the precept as a result of this.

The new lanterns will be LED white light which are energy saving and require less maintenance. It is estimated that energy and maintenance savings will be in the region of £288,000 over the next 25 years.

Sale of Land, Muxton

On Saturday 7th June between 12 noon and 4pm, this The Council is currently investigating the possibility of Parish Council will be holding an event to commemorate selling land at Saltwell's Drive, Marshbrook Way and the centenary of the start of World War 1 on Broadoaks Brands Meadow. It's solicitors are currently examining Field, Wellington Road, Donnington. The event will start the title deeds and covenants relating to these pieces of

those that gave their lives in World War 1 on the roundabout situated at the junction of Wrekin Drive and Wellington Road, Donnington. Councillors will also have poppies to plant around their wards at their discretion.

Wrekin Drive, Donnington

The Parish Council has written to Telford & Wrekin Council regarding its concerns about the increased number of heavy goods vehicles using St George's Road and Wrekin Drive as a means to access Hortonwood Industrial Estate and the affect that the proposed planning applications for the construction of a 26,000 sqm (279,862 sqft) and 875,000 sq.ft warehouse and distribution facility in Hortonwood will have. It has requested that a weight limit of 7.5 tonnes be imposed on these roads (except for deliveries to local shops) and that improved signage is erected directing these vehicles down Donnington Wood Way.

Muxton Post Office

The Post Office was officially opened at its new location at Muxton Newsagents, 16 Wellington Road, Muxton on Friday 7th February 2014 by Mark Pritchard MP. The Post Box will also be moved to the new location.

Trees at Saltwell's Drive

The Parish Council has recently had to undertake some major tree works on land at Saltwell's Drive to the rear of Thornton Park Avenue, Muxton. Over the years the trees have regenerated themselves and as a result were starting to inhibit the growth and health of others and were becoming unsafe.

Community Governance Review Ballot

A ballot has been held inviting the residents of Lilleshall to vote on whether or not they wish to have an independent Parish Council separate from Donnington and Muxton or whether to stay as Lilleshall, Donnington and Muxton Parish Council. The votes were counted at the Lilleshall Memorial Hall on Thursday 20th March. The "turn out" was 52.6%. Of the 579 electors that voted 320 voted for an independent Council with 259 voting to stay with the current Parish Council.

Parish Council Precept

Parish Councils have a statutory power to precept (tax) local government electors in their areas to finance the activities to exercise their discretionary powers and legal obligations. For 2014/2015 this Councils precept was reduced to £179,405 a reduction of 3%.
