

### The 2021 Census is almost upon us...

Households across Telford & Wrekin will soon be asked to take part in the nationwide survey of housing and the population.

It has been carried out every decade since 1801, with the exception of 1941. Information from the digital-first census will help decide how services are planned and funded in your local area. This could mean things like doctors' surgeries, housing or new bus routes.

Households will receive a letter with a unique access code in the post, allowing them to complete their questionnaire online.

Paper questionnaires will be available on request.

## COMMUNITY SPEED WATCH

Following concerns raised in your area regarding vehicles travelling at excess speed, the local Police Safer Neighbourhood Team are looking into the possibility of **introducing a**Community Speed Watch (CSW) scheme in your locality to support our efforts to address this issue.

Community Speed Watch schemes are a **community driven volunteer programme** whereby local residents are trained and equipped to monitor traffic speeds at identified problem hotspots near your homes.

They are not about catching as many drivers exceeding the speed limit as possible (the police cannot prosecute based on data recorded by volunteers), but they are about increasing driver awareness of their speed and changing behaviour. In general, there is a clear reduction in complaints regarding speeding in areas where CSW schemes exist.

All training and equipment will be provided by West Mercia Police. The times of the day, days of the week and how many times a week a scheme can operate is generally down to the volunteers themselves and their availability.

Volunteers will be subject to a basic level of police vetting. We will shortly be carrying out speed surveys in your area to confirm which streets meet the necessary requirements for a Community Speed Watch scheme to operate.

#### PRESS RELEASE—TEST CENTRES

### Two more walk-through test centres set to open in Donnington and Madeley

The site build of a new walk-through coronavirus testing facility has begun in Donnington and Madeley – meaning there are now a total of seven testing sites in Telford and Wrekin.

This means that there is plenty of testing capacity and lots of slots available for anyone who has symptoms of the virus to get tested as quickly as possible.

Set to open on 5 November, the new sites are located at Donnington Wood Bowling Club and Legges Way Car Park, Madeley.

Once open, there will be five walk-through testing centres in the borough, with two drive-through ones located in Ironbridge and Hollinswood.

Anyone with any of the three key coronavirus symptoms, however mild, can get a free swab test at the site that takes less than a minute.

"People should get their results quickly as turnaround times have improved.

Tests at the site should be booked or ordered as soon as symptoms begin at nhs.uk/coronavirus or by calling 119. Andy Burford, Cabinet Member for Health and Social Care, said: "With so many sites across the borough it's never been easier or quicker to get tested for Coronavirus.

"You can book a test 24/7 and there are a number of slots available throughout the day.

"If you have one of the three key coronavirus symptoms, however mild, please self-isolate and book a test immediately – by doing this you are playing your part to prevent the spread of the virus in Telford and Wrekin."
