Through the Parish Council's grants scheme, we have been able to support many local initiatives.

SUPPORTS KIDS

One that we are very proud to support is the provisions for young people in the local area. Last year we were able to work with Donnington & Muxton Youth Club to secure annual funding for their youth provisions, and in February 2023, it funded their day out to Twycross Zoo.

Donnington & Muxton Parish Council has paid for St Matthew's Primary School to have their bandstand replaced after it was condemned.

The Parish Council funded the project after hearing that the school had to stop using its much-loved bandstand.

The Parish Chairman was delighted and stated that "the children at St Matthew's can now enjoy the space again".

Headteacher of St Matthew's Primary Kate Clark added:

"At St Matthew's we are delighted to have received the support of £6000 from the Parish Council so we could replace our tired condemned wooden outdoor stage with a wonderful new composite stage which should outlive us all."

"The children were so excited to see it reinstalled on our school field and are very much looking forward to utilising it in the summer months ahead."




#### **DONNINGTON SNUG**


#### PARISH CLERK RAISES MONEY FOR CHARITY

It aims to offer a space where students can come and feel safe and comfortable outside of sixth-form/college hours.


Library computers would be available for use along with light refreshments, quiet areas for reading or relaxing, table tennis, chess and much more.

## **PARISH DOGET 2023-2024**

Donnington and Muxton Parish Council Budget for the 2023-24 financial year was agreed at Full Council on 12th December 2022

The Parish Precept totals £206,302, a 0% increase on last year.

This is based on the average Band D equivalent of 3872.5 houses within the Parish.

This works out at an average per household of £53.26/yr (Band D)
